CHÂTEAU DE BEAUREGARD HAS BEEN OWNED BY THE BURRIER FAMILY FOR 6 GENERATIONS AND IS REGARDED AS ONE OF THE MAJOR PROPERTIES OF THE SOUTH OF BURGUNDY, IN THE MÂCONNAIS/BEAUJOLAIS REGION. THE VINEYARDS COVER 42 HA, INCLUDING 22 HA OF POUILLY-FUISSÉ, 7 HA OF SAINT-VÉRAN AND 12 HA OF FLEURIE, MORGON, MOULIN-À-VENT, SAINT-AMOUR AND CHIROUBLES

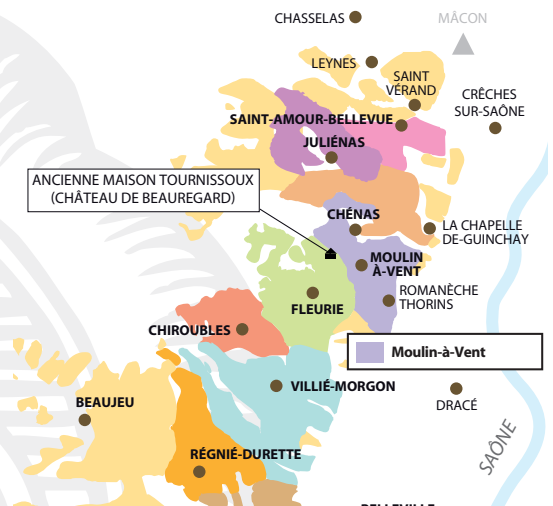

DESCRIPTION OF THE TERROIR

We are in the south of Burgundy, in the Beaujolais region where Moulin à Vent is considered as the most Burgundian of the ten Crus of Beaujolais, probably due to its ageing capacity. Total size of the Appellation: 620 ha.

Besides the superb plots 'Clos des Pérelles' and 'Salomine', Château de Beauregard also owns a vineyard called 'Les Petits Bois', on the pink granite and clay Terroir of the south of Romanèche-Thorins, producing precise and balanced wines. The Moulin à Vent 'Classique' of Château de Beauregard comes mainly from 'Les Petits Bois' and from some 'pièces' of 'Pérelles' and 'Salomine'.



VINES AND VITICULTURE

Grape variety: Gamay 100% - Average age of the vines: 35 years. The vineyard is managed to promote microbial life in the soil, to encourage deep rooting of the vines. Strict control of the yields; culture respectful of the environment; 100% hand picked.

WINEMAKING AND DESCRIPTION OF THE WINE

Sorted on a vibrant table as soon as they arrive in our winery of Fleurie (former Maison Tournissoux) the grapes follow a traditional vinification (opposite to the modern style 'en Primeur') in order to reveal its typical Terroir expression. After de-stemming the fermenting process (using 'pigeage' and 'remontage') will last 6 to 10 days depending on the vintage.

The Moulin à Vent is aged in 'Pièces' (228l oak casks) during 9 months. This deep ruby colored wine expresses red fruits (strawberry, blackcurrant) and flowers (iris, rose petal and violet). Well structured and balanced our Moulin à Vent will age 8 to 10 years after bottling.

FOOD MATCHING

Serve between 14 and 17°C in large crystal glasses.

Our Moulin à Vent matches well with grilled or 'en sauce' meats, 'coq au vin', game and not too matured cheese.
