MÂCON-VERGISSON 2015

A more elegant and slightly fresher nose offers up more pronounced notes of mineral reduction, smoked apple and a plenitude of citrus elements. The palate impression of the energetic medium-bodied flavors is distinctly stony as the natural minerality of Vergisson is very much on parade, all wrapped in a relatively refined and more complex finale where the only nit is a hint of warmth. Still, this is really very good for a regional wine and is well-worth considering. (2019+)

MÂCON-VERZÉ 2015

This offers up a similar aromatic profile with the addition of a whisper of mineral reduction character. This is also round, fleshy and delicious though the medium weight flavors flash a bit more vibrancy that also suffuses the intensely saline-inflected finale. A quality effort for its level. (2018+)

VIRÉ-CLESSÉ "QUINTAINE" 2015


There is a trace of the exotic to the honeyed aromas of mandarin orange and floral scents. The rich and dense but appealingly vibrant middle weight flavors possess reasonably good. (2019+)

A notably floral nose reflects notes of pear, apple and a whiff of citrus. The rich, round and fleshy middle weight flavors offer acceptable depth and persistence on the delicious yet satisfying finale. To enjoy young. (2018+)
