MÂCON-BUSSIÈRES “MONT SARD” 2016

Once again there is an abundance of petrol character to the nose that is comprised mostly by notes of honeysuckle and lemon rind.

Somewhat surprisingly this is actually fresher and more energetic on the palate with its delicious, intense and very dry finale. For its level this too is worth checking out. (2020+)

MÂCON-MILLY-LAMARTINE “MONTAGNE DE CRAS ” 2016


I had tried this just after it was bottled and it has become somewhat more interesting with its overtly fruity nose that mixes various white fruit scents with those of mostly grapefruit and lemongrass. The rich, round and plump flavors exude a subtle salinity which adds a refreshing element to the delicious and lightly mineral-inflected finish that flashes a touch of youthful austere. (2020+)

BOURGOGNE-ALIGOTÉ “LES 17 RANGS” 2016

A spicy nose reflects notes of green apple, lemongrass and grapefruit.

The delicious, vibrant and punchy flavors possess a very clean mouth feel while evidencing plenty of citrus influence on the notably dry, focused and sneaky long finish. This is a quality Aligoté and worth checking out if you like the variety. (2019+)
