88**MÂÇON-VERGISSON 2017**


A slightly cooler and airier nose features notes of petrol, apple, pear and a hint of citrus. There is fine richness and noticeably more minerality present on the palate of the medium-bodied flavors that deliver slightly better length on the slightly drier finish. This too should drink well upon release. (Now+)

87**MÂÇON-FUISSÉ 2017**

An exotic but fresh nose combines notes of lychee, passion fruit, citrus and a whiff of spiced pear. There is fine density to the caressing, generous and plump middle weight flavors that conclude in a clean and dry if slightly warm finish. This should drink well basically upon release. (Now+)

87**VIRÉ-CLESSÉ “QUINTAINE” 2017**

An overtly exotic nose offers up honeyed notes that are markedly phenolic (olive oil nuances) in character. The succulent and very round flavors also possess plenty of mouth coating sap that imparts an almost chewy texture to the rustic and ever-so-slightly warm finish. Once again, this should be enjoyable young. (Now+)
