CHÂTEAU DE BEAUREGARD / JOSEPH BURRIER

(91-94)**POUILLY-FUISSÉ
VERS CRAS 2015**

This wine really spreads out on the back end to saturate the palate. Wonderfully tactile, long and alive.

(92-94)**POUILLY-FUISSÉ
GRAND BEAUREGARD
2014**

Great class and an ineffable lightness of being here, but this potentially great Pouilly-Fuissé is extremely unevolved.

93**POUILLY-FUISSÉ
VERS CRAS 2014**

Wonderfully elegant, precise and fine-grained... Classy, seamless and utterly distinctive... this beauty finishes with terrific lift.

(91-93)**POUILLY-FUISSÉ
LA MARÉCHAUDÉ 2015**

Knockout nose. Wonderfully deep and unctuous... remarkably thick yet energetic wine, which promises to be a high point of the vintage.

92**POUILLY-FUISSÉ
VIGNES BLANCHES
2014**

This rather powerful, very long wine is consistent from start to finish and thus already a satisfying mouthful.

93**POUILLY-FUISSÉ
LES INSARTS 2014**

This highly distinctive wine is a very successful amalgam of traditional and more modern-styled Pouilly-Fuissé.

(89-91)**POUILLY-FUISSÉ
LES INSARTS 2015**

Thick and hugely rich in a rather New World way, with yellow stone fruit flavors complicated by a lichee quality... Unmistakably a fruit bomb of a Chardonnay.

91+**POUILLY-FUISSÉ
LA MARÉCHAUDÉ 2014**

Lemon cream and crushed herb flavors build impressively toward the back, leaving the mouth perfumed. Finishes salty, seductive and very long.

90**POUILLY-FUISSÉ 2014**

A retaste of the 2014 revealed a distinctly more lemony wine with expressive flinty minerality, strong acidity and superb clarity and length.

89**POUILLY-FUISSÉ 2015**

Wonderfully sweet and fat but not heavy, with an accent of clove spice providing lift to the yellow fruit flavors.

92+**POUILLY-FUISSÉ
LES CRAYS 2014**

Large-scaled, immensely rich, ripe and sweet but with a lively spine of acidity and strong, almost bitter-edged stony minerality running through it. A Côte d'Or style of wine.

89+**POUILLY-FUISSÉ
AUX CHARMES 2014**

I'd wait a few years for this very taut wine to relax a bit and display more texture.

90-95 : Outstanding. A wine of remarkable personality and breed that is well worth seeking out.

85-89 : Excellent. A strong wine with true character that provides highly enjoyable drinking.
